9/11 Memorial Service ~ September 11, 2011

*Standing with our community
to remember...*

So many of you have expressed excitement about our involvement in the Traverse City 9/11 Memorial Service this coming Sunday morning. It's shaping up to be an amazing service and opportunity to join with our community for this meaningful event! Here are some reminders as you make your plans for Sunday!

When: 8:30 AM (shoot for 8:00 or earlier, so you have time to park and get good seats)

Where: Traverse City Open Space

Parking: Across the Parkway from the Open Space in the public parking area - handicap spaces are available on site at the Open Space

Seating: 1500 seats will be available - chairs and bleachers (first come, first serve)

What: 9/11 Memorial Service points of interest:

- Steel beam from the World Trade Center, which will become a permanent memorial in Traverse City
- Musical tribute by EBCC musicians
- Addresses from dignitaries and GT Metro Fire Chief Patrick Parker
- 21 Gun Salute, 343 Fire Bell
- Bagpipes "Amazing Grace"
- Coast Guard "Fly-Over"

Inclement Weather: This service will be held "rain or shine." In the case of severe weather (lightning) the service will be cancelled. The weather forecast is looking perfect as of right now!

Set Up: There is still room for more people to set up and tear down for this event. Loading up begins on Saturday @ 6:00

PM at the church, and set-up begins at approximately 6:45 PM the same evening at the Open Space. Tear-down will be shortly after 11:00 AM on Sunday after our "Prayer in the Park" service.

Directly following the community 9/11 memorial service at the Open Space, we would like you to join us at Lay Park for a time of prayer and worship (combined with Bible Baptist Church). Here are some things to remember as you make your plans to attend:

Where: Lay Park (a couple blocks South of the Open Space on Union Street, across from the City Bike Shop)

Parking: There is a small parking lot adjacent to the park that we'd like to reserve for those with limited mobility

Seating: Seating will not be provided. This service will not be lengthy, but if you wish to bring a lawn chair, you are welcome to do so.

What: A simple time of corporate worship and prayer for our community and country

Inclement Weather: In case of rain, we will hold a service at East Bay Calvary Church at the regular 10:30 AM worship time.

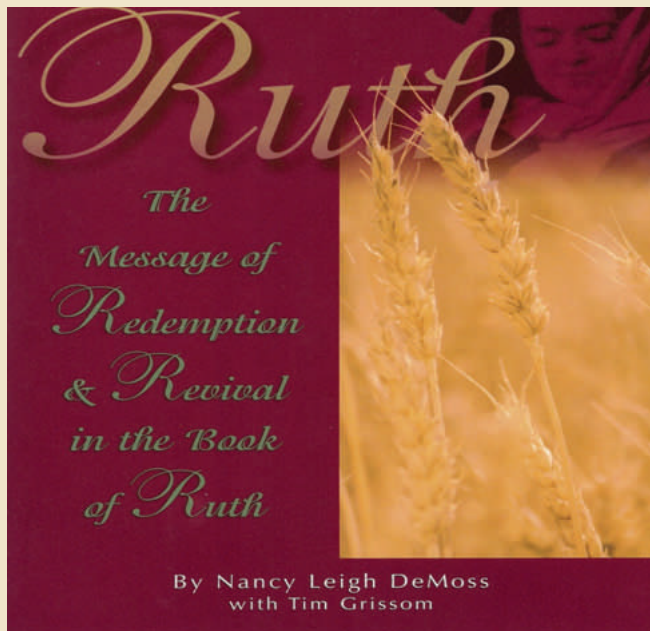
