



# STUDY QUESTIONS FOR **DECEMBER 22**

**Series: *Even Better***

**EVEN BETTER than the Prophets! (Hebrews 1:1-4)**

## **Introduction**

1. Who do you feel are the most important people to listen to today? Why?
2. If you were to describe someone in the world today who is truly amazing, what might you say about them?

## **Digging Deeper**

3. Make 10 observations about **Hebrews 1:1-4**. What stands out to you in these verses?
4. **Read 2 Peter 1:20-21**. Who is the source of all of the prophecy of Scripture? Why can't we come up with prophecy on our own?
5. **Read 2 Peter 1:16-19**. How did Peter and other New Testament authors come up with what to say about Jesus? How closely does it tie into what Old Testament prophets had written?
6. **Read Acts 3:22-26**. What were all the Old Testament prophets pointing forward to? How is it that Jesus is a prophet?
7. **Read Matthew 16:13-17**. Were the crowds wrong in thinking that Jesus was a prophet? How close were their answers to the truth?
8. What did you hear in the message this Sunday that stood out to you? Is there anything you would emphasize, add, or change?

## **Application**

9. Take time to appreciate the technology that's surrounding you moment by moment. What technology is making everything around you possible right now? How does lack of such awareness deaden our thankfulness?
10. All that we have in Jesus is a revolution in revelation that we take for granted! Build a list with two columns: one of what's true about Jesus, and the other of what that means for you. Keep engaged in praising Jesus for all that He is!
